## USQ Name Change

- Current public position is that we have not engaged in the process at the moment. QA is dedicated to providing a safe community for everyone. Possibly open to changing the name in Australia.
- **Action 1: Jamie to reach out to the IQA and USQ to understand how each organisation will approach the process, and how Australia can be involved.**



## **IQA Continental Games**

- A team representing Australia will be formed from scratch.
- **Action 2: Executive to ask team representatives if players are interested in competing in Continental games through a jotform.**

## **Mardi Gras**

- It will cost \$30 to be part of the parade.
- The volunteer group will receive automatic offers. All other positions will be determined by ballot with consideration for a diverse representation from teams.
- Jersey's are not a part of the entry price and will be an additional cost. There will be a special mardi gras version of the jersey.
- We should consider a dress code.

## **Vaccine Mandate**

- We need to consider all states individual circumstances, and seek legal advice before this can be considered.
- **Action 3: Nicola to research government vaccination guidelines**
- **Action 4: Matt to reach out to other sports to understand their vaccination policies.**

## **State Communication**

- Luke will meet with each state monthly, to be organised by Luke.
- There will be regular email updates to all members.
- We should encourage state boards to join QA committees when appropriate.
- **Action 5: Luke to organise monthly meetings with each state**
- **Action 6: Jamie and Rebecca to make an email template for QA updates**

## **2022 Membership**

- We need the terms and conditions from Revolution Sport before we can agree to move forward with them.
- Should organise a meeting with Revolution sport to understand the system
- A tiered system of membership prices is incorporated into the strategic plan. We will commit to the tiered system, but prices should be discussed in slack.
- Nicola needs to read over full terms and conditions
