### 2022 Memberships

- We have two options that are fairly cheap and good Joinit and Revolutionise Sport. I recommend Joinit. They have flexible fields, \$49/month and a service fee of 2.5% per transaction.
- We need further investigation on the back end of the platforms to determine if it is an improvement from jotform.

- There should be a list of questions for Scott so he can adequately answer our questions
- We should also start a conversation with States about new membership platforms, integrating assets and charging a state fee

#### **Return to Play Policies**

- A vaccine policy needs to be implemented for NSW. Training can resume with 20 fully vaccinated participants.
- We can't store vaccination certificates.
- A COVID safe plan needs to be uploaded in the event sanctioning form.
- The event organiser needs to submit a form with a list of participants and certifying they have cited their vaccination certificates. This data will be recorded in the membership spreadsheet.
- The process needs to be clearly communicated.
- COVID marshals and liability needs to be investigated.
- Our vaccine policy will need to communicate vaccination status data collected by QA will be accessible to tournament organisers.

#### 2022 Board Roles

- We need to clarify the return to play for concussion injuries we have 12 days where the recommended is 8. Need to understand why.
- Kelsey needs to read the policies before they are approved
- Once approved they will be immediately put in place with a grace period.
