
Meeting Opened: 8:58pm

#### **Membership Debrief**

- Scott had a meeting with the company
- They can't be clear about what the options for gender are, but they will be done by the middle of June
- They are willing to put into the contract the guarantee it will be resolved by June
- They recommend to move across when the system is ready
  - It would take a couple of week to get data from Jotform onto the new system
- Money from membership costs would come in weekly
  - o It would be beneficial to raise prices to cover the membership fees
  - The payment platform would incur fees
- We would like to wait until they have the updated gender field in Jan 2022
- Action: Scott to stay in touch with the company

#### IQA

- The US have written to the IQA to appeal their decision for delaying the world cup until after 2022
- QA agrees their with their decision but would like to see the IQA accountable to their letter we would like a response to the questions raised
- We would like to know how their insurance works
